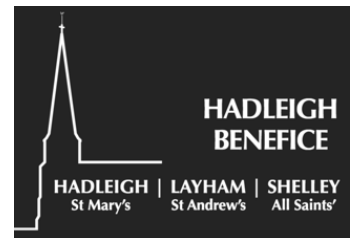

HLF grant: We have received news from HLF about the application we made for funding the first phase of the re-ordering, and sadly they have turned us down on this occasion. We will know more about their reasons when we receive the formal letter, but they have already said it was an excellent application and are happy to work with us to ensure a more successful outcome next time. We already have a meeting with them arranged for January to take things forward. So, we are certainly not giving up; many successful projects have had to apply more than once.

Appointment of new incumbent: The Hadleigh Benefice will have a new priest-in-charge sometime in 2018. Listening to the views of worshippers, as well as the wider community, is an important part of the appointment process.

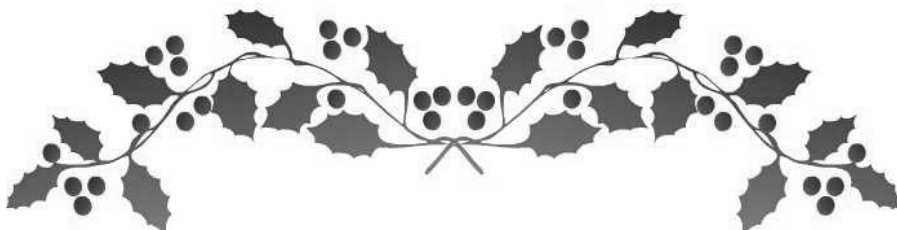
St Mary's will be locked from 12noon on Christmas Day, and will remain locked on Boxing Day.
