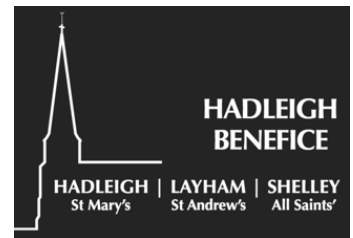

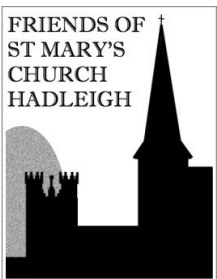
NOTICES AND FUTURE EVENTS
