

Unfortunately we weren't able to make an appointment after the recent interviews. After prayer and reflection, the person we recommended to the Bishop didn't believe it was right for him to accept the post for personal reasons. We understand that St John's College Cambridge will pay for the post to be re-advertised, and a revised advertisement will be published very soon. We hope to hold interviews in mid-July.

Canon John Parr's last Sunday in the benefice will be on July 1<sup>st</sup>. Details of his last services in the benefice will be publicised once they are known.

Once John has gone, the benefice will for all practical purposes be in 'interregnum'. During this time, the church wardens are in charge and will meet regularly. It is the custom in the Church of England not to introduce any changes, however minor, during an interregnum. That's not the same as church life going on 'hold', but it does mean that the inevitable disruption will be minimised.
