

Appointing a new incumbent

The churchwardens of all 3 parishes have worked hard to produce a revised advertisement that we feel better reflects what we are looking for - and what we can offer. The new advert is now out, with a closing date of 6 July, and the interview process will take place on 17/18 July. Please continue to pray for all involved, and for the right appointment.

Canon John Parr's last Sunday in the benefice will be on July 1st. Details of his last services in the benefice are now confirmed, and John will take the 8am service at St Mary's, a 9.15 Eucharist at Shelley (joint with Layham) and the 10.45 Sung Eucharist at St Mary's.

Once John has gone, the benefice will for all practical purposes be in 'interregnum'. During this time, the church wardens are in charge and will meet regularly. It is the custom in the Church of England not to introduce any changes, however minor, during an interregnum. That's not the same as church life going on 'hold', but it does mean that the inevitable disruption will be minimised.
