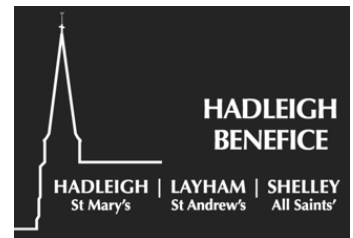

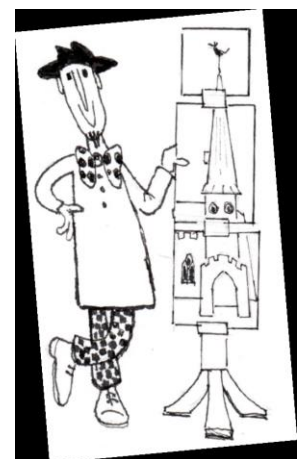
Defibrillator Training at St Mary's: one session remaining - April 9th, 6pm – 8pm
