

Passion Sunday



All three church buildings in the benefice are now closed until further notice.

A card is being delivered to each member of the Church (with spares available) with a short form of **Morning and Evening Prayer**. Please have these as an aid to your daily prayer.

A second card will be offered with simple prayers to be said over some bread and wine at home. Fr Jo will preside in a private **Eucharist** (Communion/Mass) at **10 am on each Sunday** and we hope that we can then receive together 'temporally'.
