

St Mary's is open for private prayer and visitors from 8:30 am to 5pm every day; St Andrew's and All Saints' are open daily.



A Midsummer Festival of Flowers, Music and Art: continues today, Sunday 26 June (1pm-5pm), at St Mary's. Do come along and enjoy 32 fantastic floral displays, as well as work by local artists.

This Friday is a 'first Friday' so do come along to St Mary's Café Church and support the **Craft and Produce Market** and Patsy's fabulous **Second-Hand Stall**. Patsy and her team have now raised somewhere in the region of £1400 for church funds since she started the stall in October!

St Mary's is hosting a concert with the **Suffolk Philharmonic Orchestra** on Sunday 10 July at 4pm. This is the final concert in the 'The Lark's Flight over Suffolk' series that is touring various parts of the county, and we expect a large audience (over 170 tickets sold already!). They would like us to provide refreshments for the interval – so we need volunteers please to serve wine and soft drinks. It requires a minimum of 4 people (6 would be better) – and it would need setting up beforehand as well. Free/ reduced tickets might be negotiated for those who volunteer! All bar profits will go to church funds. Please tell Claire if you can volunteer.
